Instructions for the 2026 EJU [For Overseas Applicants]

- Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students -

1. Details of the EJU

(1) Aims

This examination is used to evaluate the Japanese language proficiency and basic academic abilities of international students who wish to study at the undergraduate level at universities or other such higher educational institutions in Japan.

(2) Examination Subjects

According to the requirements of the university they want to enter and the course of study they want to pursue, the examinees select the examination subject from the following table. Examinees may not choose to take both the Science and the Japan and the World.

Mathematics	Measurement of the basic academic skills in mathematics necessary for studying at Japanese universities.	80 minutes	0-200

The score range mentioned above, excluding the writing of Japanese as a Foreign Language, will not be given in the form of the raw score but on a common scale. The writing will be scored based on the standard.

(3) The Structure and Evaluation of Japanese as a Foreign Language

- a. Structure: The test in Japanese as a Foreign Language consists of writing, reading comprehension, and listening and listening-reading comprehension.
- b. Order and Time: The order of the examinations is writing (30 minutes), reading comprehension (40 minutes), listening-reading comprehension, and listening comprehension (about 55 minutes including listening-reading comprehension and listening comprehension).
- c. Score range: The score range 0-400 totaling reading 0-200, and listening comprehension and listening- reading comprehension 0-200, and the score range 0-50 for writing will be indicated.

(4) The Structure of Science

In the science area, according to the requirements of the university they want to enter and the course of study they want to pursue, **examinees have to select two subjects from physics, chemistry and biology on the examination day**. In case only one subject is selected, your answer for science will not be graded.

(5) The Structure of Mathematics

In the mathematics area, according to the requirements of the university they want to enter and the course of study they want to pursue, **examinees have to select either Course 1 for liberal arts faculties or science faculties where comparatively less mathematics is required, or Course 2 for faculties where higher level mathematics is required on the examination day.**

(6) Subject Test Syllabi

A syllabus for each subject is posted on the JASSO website.
The revised syllabuses for “Science,” “Japan and the World,” and “Mathematics” go into effect from the 2026 EJU.

(7) Examination Language

The questions will be written in Japanese or English. (The examination of Japanese as a Foreign Language will be written only in Japanese.) The Japanese and English question booklets will be separated. According to the requirements of the university they want to enter and the course of study they want to pursue, **the examinees need to select the language in the application.**

(8) Answering Method

For Japanese as a Foreign Language, the answering methods are multiple-choice (mark-sheet) and writing (examinees are to actually write Japanese sentences.). For mathematics, science, Japan and the World, the method is the mark-sheet.

2. University Requirements on Subject Test Selection

EJU scores earned over the past two years (results from a maximum of four sessions) remain valid. Please be aware that Japanese university requirements of examination subjects and languages regarding EJU vary according to each institution. While some universities (or some departments/courses) require international students to take designated subject of the examination, other universities (or departments/courses) do not require students to take the examination. Also, some universities accept only the results of the 1st session (June), while others accept only the results of the 2nd session (November). They may designate the specific years and the number of exams that may be used when submitting applications. Therefore, **before submitting your examination application, make sure you contact the university to which you will apply and ask about their latest requirements.**

The list of schools offering “Pre-arrival Admission” using EJU (SAMPLE) is placed at the end of this book. (The “Pre-arrival Admission” is a system to secure admission to the higher educational institutions in Japan without having to go to Japan for the exam.) Some of schools publish their acceptance level or minimum required scores. Please browse the JASSO website for details. In addition, the list of Japanese universities that use EJU scores for the selection of enrollees is posted on the JASSO website. Please refer to it for selecting your school.

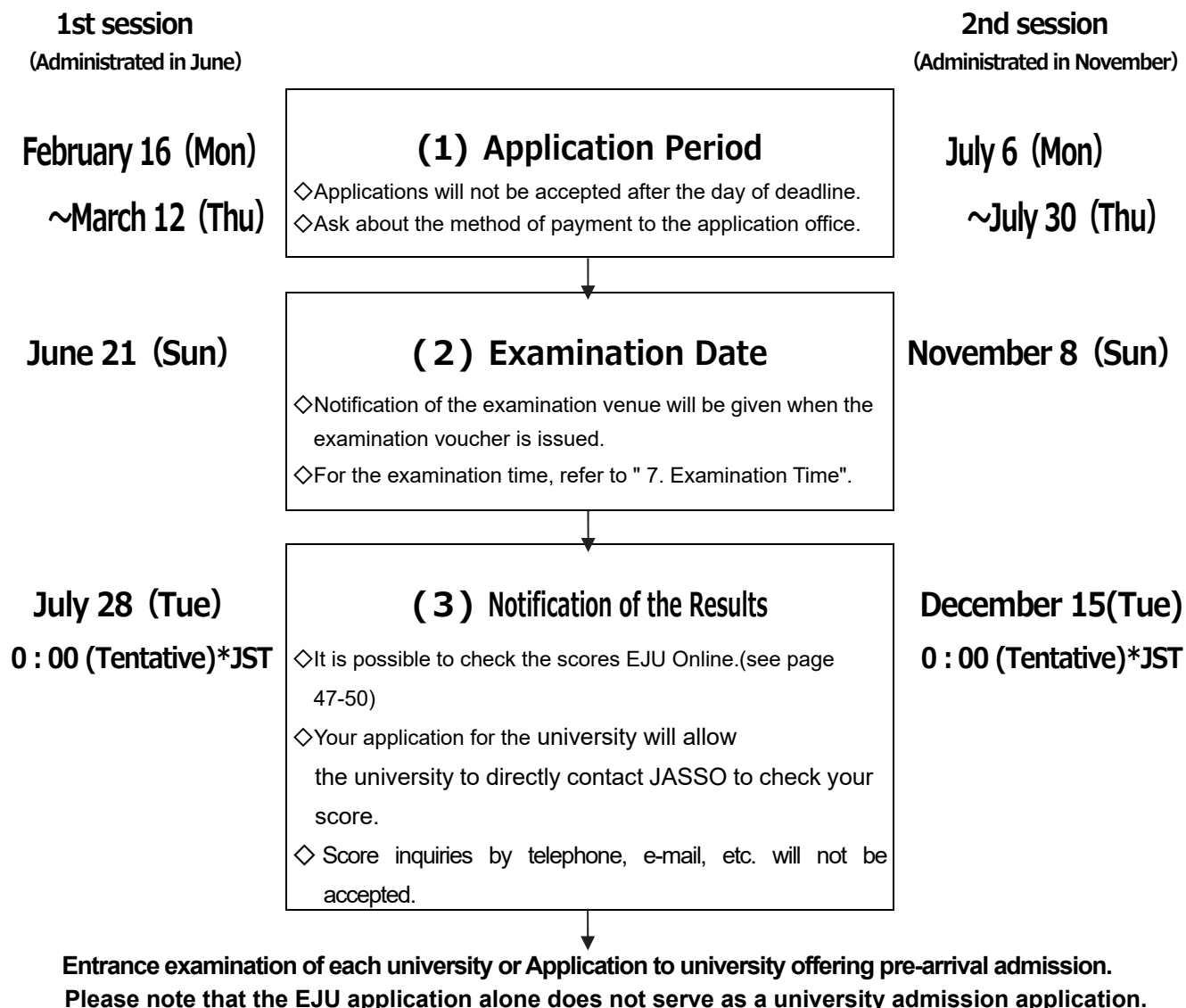
◆Acceptance Level or Minimum required scores of EJU

5. Application Procedures

(1) How to Fill in the Application Form

Fill in the required spaces as designated in the section "How to Fill in the Application Form" on page 61-62.

(2) Submission of the Application Form

a. Required Documents:

- **Application Form** (Four pages. Fill in all the required information.)

- **3 photographs of the face** (4cm in length and 3cm in width)

(Stick them to the three designated frame on the application form with glue.)

*Please submit a passport-style portrait photo (head and shoulders) without background.

*Please confirm on the last page "Instructions for your Photograph" carefully.

b. Submission Method: Submit those Required Documents to the application office listed on page 54-55.

NOTE: After the application form has been submitted, the information written on the form such as examination subjects, examination language, examination site etc. cannot be changed.

6. Testing Accommodation for Examinees with Disabilities

If you need testing accommodation to take the examination, **please read 'Information on Accommodations for the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students'. If it takes time to arrange the methods, there may be a possibility that accommodations will not be ready in time for the exam you wish to take. Please consult with '19. Application offices' well in advance, even before the application period begins.**

(1) As a general rule, you have to prepare an evidence such as a doctor's diagnosis proving the necessity of testing accommodation due to an illness, injury or disorder etc..

You have to apply for testing accommodations for the use of hearing aids.

(2) You should also apply testing accommodation if you wish to do something that is not permitted during examination period, refer to "11. Cautions Regarding the Examination".

9. Examination Vouchers

- (1) Examination vouchers will be sent to the address that you wrote on the "Label for sending notification of results" or delivered at the application office.
- (2) If you do not receive your voucher, contact the application office.
- (3) Even if the voucher contains any errors in your name (limited to differences of one or two characters), sex, date of birth, or country/region, please take the examination using the voucher as is. **After the**

examination ends, inform the proctor regarding the error by the end of the examination day. If you fail to do so, your score and information to be notified to universities, etc. will contain the same error. However, changes to both the name and date of birth, significant changes to the name (such as changing the surname or given name, and changes to the photo) are not permitted.

10. Venue

A map of the venue and other information will be sent with the examination voucher.

Cautions:

- Until the examination day, please make sure the route to the examination venue, public transportation departure/arrival times, and other travel details so that you can arrive on time. Please note that you cannot enter the venue building prior to the examination day.
- If you fail to arrive on time, you will not be permitted to take the examination.
- The application office will answer to the inquiries how to get the venue.
- Persons other than EJU staff and examinees are not permitted to enter the venue building during the examination.
- Please obey instructions given by the examination staff and follow the usage rule of examination site. If you disobey and your action is regarded as one of the prohibited behaviors (refer to P.36-38), you may be asked to retire from the examination.
- If public transportation becomes unavailable due to an accident, strike, etc. on the examination day, please promptly contact the application office.

11. Cautions Regarding the Examination

If you want to do something not permitted under this section, apply for testing accommodation, refer to "6. Testing Accommodation for Examinees with Disabilities".

(1) Things to Bring on the Examination Day: Make sure you bring the following items.

- Examination Voucher (Do not write anything on the Examination Voucher.)
- Identification with photo

Note: This will be necessary for **identification** when entering the venue.

Note: If you forget your identification with photo or bring anything other than the original, you will not be able to take the exam.

- Writing Implements (HB pencils, a plain plastic eraser (remove the eraser from its case), pencil sharpeners)

* Mechanical pencils or stacking pencils may not be allowed to use. There is a possibility that the mark sheet may not be readable.

* Retractable erasers, pencil caps, electric pencil sharpeners, large pencil sharpeners, and knives may not be allowed to use.

* Writing Implements will not be provided.

- d. Watch (Not allowed for items with functions such as dictionaries, calculators, terminals, etc., or items that are difficult to identify whether such functions are available or not.)

Note: Watches should not be worn on the wrist but placed on the desk.

Note: Cancel the alarm sound setting beforehand.

Note: Make sure you bring your own watch since some of examination rooms may not be equipped with a clock. **Do not use a mobile phone or other such device as a watch.**

- e. Lunch (As it is held on a Sunday, restaurants and shops near the examination venue may be closed.)

* You cannot use earplugs since they may disturb you in listening to instructions, etc. of the proctor.

* At some test venues, it is impossible to adjust the room temperature. Therefore examinees are requested to wear temperature-adjustable clothing.

(2) Confirmation of Personal Identity (Important)

On the day of the examination, the personal photo ID and examination vouchers will be used to identify the examinees. The personal photo ID must be originals only. Copies and images will not be accepted.

Cases when such personal ID is not presented or it otherwise proves impossible to confirm personal identity, you cannot take the exam.

* Submission after the exam is not allowed.

(3) Time of Entering the Examination Room

- a. The examination room opens 30 minutes before the start time of the Japanese as a Foreign Language.
b. Enter the examination room before the start time of each subject.
c. No one is allowed to enter the examination room 10 minutes after the start time of the Japanese as a Foreign Language, or 20 minutes after the start time of other subject. (See “8. Tardiness Limits”).

(4) Notes about the Examination Room

- a. Find the seat with the same number as your examination registration number and place your voucher on the desk. You cannot take the examination at a seat with a different number.
b. Items you are allowed to put on your desk during the examination are as 11. (1) a, c, d only. Do not wear a wristwatch, remove it from your wrist and place it on the desk. Make sure that anything else is kept in your bag.
c. Eating or drinking is not allowed during the examination. Do not place food or drink on your desk.
d. **Switch the power to “OFF” for all mobile phones, smartphones or other electronic devices (refer to section 11. (7) b. for details), and place those devices in your bag. Such items may not be kept in the pockets of your clothing.**

Please remember that activating the alarm function on mobile phones or other devices can cause the alarm even if the power is switched off. To avoid this, deactivate the alarm setting and then switch the power to “OFF.”

- e. After the examination begins, no one is allowed to leave the examination room until an announcement is made that “examinees may now leave.” If you need to use the restroom or step outside due to feeling ill before that time, raise your hand. Please remember, however, **that during the audio part of the Listening Comprehension and Listening-Reading Comprehension sections of the Japanese as a Foreign Language test, even if receiving permission to visit the restroom or leave the examination room due to not feeling well, you will not be allowed to return to the room until after those sections**

have concluded.

- f. During the Japanese as a Foreign Language test Listening Comprehension and Listening-Reading Comprehension questions, do not ask questions, speak or cause loud noises.
- g. If you cannot properly hear the recorded audio played during the Japanese as a Foreign Language Listening Comprehension and Listening-Reading Comprehension testing due to noise or other reasons, please raise your hand after the recording finishes and inform a staff member of the problem.
- h. This testing cannot be repeated no matter interferences from everyday noises occurring during the test. This includes footstep sounds of staffers walking around the room, conversations required to administer the test, sounds of passing airplanes or automobiles, wind and rain, air conditioning, coughing, sneezing or nose blowing by other examinees in your vicinity, short-term ringing of portable telephones, watches or other devices, noise from nearby buildings or other distractions.
- i. Because your examination voucher is required upon applying to universities or other institutions, keep it safely after the testing is completed.

(5) Answering Method

The answering method is **mark-sheet**. **Make sure you use an HB pencil to fill in the number for the answer.** You cannot use a mechanical pencil or a ball-point pen. Numbers that are filled in too lightly will not be marked. Examination scores are calculated by totaling the points for all correct answers. No points will be subtracted for incorrect answers. For more details of the answering method, refer to 15. Answering Method.

(6) Your Name and Examination Registration Number on the Answer Sheet

Your name (in the Roman alphabet) and examination registration number will be pre-printed on your answer sheet that will be provided on the examination day. When you are given the answer sheet, first of all, check that the name and examination registration number on the answer sheet are the same as those on your examination voucher. If the name and examination registration number on the answer sheet are obviously not yours, notify the examination staff immediately.

If you write answers on an answer sheet that is not yours or if you correct the name and examination registration number by yourself without notifying the staff, your examination will not be graded.

(7) Prohibited Behaviors

If you behave in the following ways, it will be regarded as prohibited behavior. Accordingly, you will be ordered by the examination staff to leave the examination room, and your answers of the subjects that you took will be invalidated. (Examination fee shall not be refunded.)

- a. **The identity of the examinee cannot be sufficiently verified. (See (2))**
- b. **Electronic devices such as a mobile phone, etc. that make sounds or generate the vibration noise during the examination. (They include a wristwatch generating alarm sounds.)**
- c. **Place one of electric devices on your chair or desk instead of being put away in a bag, hold it in your hand, wear it on yourself, or use/operate it during the examination.(Even just turning the power on is considered as cheating.)**

Examples of electronic devices; mobile phone, smartphone, PC, PDA (personal data assistant) wearable terminal such as smartwatch, IC recorders, audio players, digital camera, etc. having

functions of photographing, video/audio recording or communication, game machines, electronic dictionary, calculator, etc. (It will be regarded as prohibited behavior even if you just put your earphone or headphones round your neck.)

- d. Attempting to have or having someone else take the examination on your behalf.
- e. Intentionally write answers on an answer sheet which is not yours, or you exchange your question booklet or answer sheet with another examinee in the examination venue.
- f. You speak with other examinees, give answers to other examinees, receive answers from other examinees, or commit other acts of cheating (looking at a reference book, crib, newspaper, handbill or the answer sheet of another examinee) during the examination.
- g. Attempting to take or took the question booklet or answer sheets out of the examination room during or after the examination. (incl. acts of copying, photographing or audio recording the question booklet or answer sheets.)
- h. Removing or attempting to remove a page or portions of the question booklet.
- i. **Attempting to use of any kinds of memo or paper that you brought to the venue, during the examination.**
This includes writing on your examination voucher which is allowed to put on the desk, its envelope, the examination number seal, the desk, etc.. (Do not write anything even if being unrelated to the exam. Such act will be determined as prohibited behavior.)
- j. Leaving the examination room without permission of the examination staff.
- k. **Opening the question booklet or start to answer before the proctor says, "Please start."**
- l. You don't stop writing on the answer sheet when the proctor says, "Please stop."
- m. **During "Japanese as a Foreign Language" examination, looking at questions of another section or answering to another section, for example responding to "Reading Comprehension" questions during the "Writing" section.**
- n. Before the start of "Japanese as a Foreign Language" test, looking at other questions or answer the actual questions in the "Listening-Reading Comprehension" or "Listening Comprehension" section during the practice exercise.
- o. Leaving the examination room after the end of the examination but before the staff has collected and checked the question booklets and the answer sheets.
- p. Creating disturbance to other examinees.
- q. Attempting to make a false declaration regarding the examination that would give themselves or another examinee an advantage.
- r. Examination staff determines that you failed to follow any of the test administration rule than those listed above or **fail to follow the directions given by the examination staff.**
Committing an act that may undermine the fairness of the examination.

Note: The items which are used for Prohibited Behavior (memo, crib or electric devices etc.) shall be confiscated on the spot and be never returned.

Note: Committing an act as described in (b) during the exam, the staff will check emails and chat history of your smartphone or other electronic device and contents of data folders (images, video, audio, etc.) on the spot and retain those records.

Note: Examinees (and their accomplices) who engage in actions that may affect the fairness of the exam, criminal activities, violence or intimidation against the exam organizers, or obstructive

actions using unjust means such as deception (including stealing exam questions or engaging in fraudulent activities such as proxy testing) will be reported to the police. Additionally, such individuals will be prohibited from applying for and taking the exam for the next two years (four exam sessions). In such cases, even if they apply, they will not be allowed to take the exam, and the exam fee will not be refunded. Notification of the prohibition will be sent to the contact information registered at the time of application. Furthermore, if universities or other institutions inquire about the examinee's scores, they will be notified of the invalidation of the scores.

(8) Copyright of examination questions

The examination questions of EJU are confidential information and the copyright of JASSO, and are protected by laws and regulations. You are prohibited to convey a part or all of the examination questions to a third party in whatever form, such as disclosure (e.g. disclosing inappropriately obtained examination questions or providing flash reports on answers), revelation, dictation, transmission, etc. through web site or other means by copying, recording on video tape or audio tape, writing, memorizing (storing), etc. Violation of this rule may result in legal actions. Please be aware that you are also prohibited to memorize and replicate examination questions as well as to watch these contents or divulge them.

(9) About Cheating and other malicious prohibited behaviors

Jasso will continue to take strict measures against cheating. In addition, malicious cheating may be reported to the universities you want to attend.

(10) About Problems, etc. that occur during the Examination

The Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO) pledges to do everything in its capacity to ensure that the examination is offered in a proper fashion. However, upon occurrence of events during the exam which interfere with your ability to respond or otherwise threaten to impact your scores, please immediately inform a proctor of those circumstances. Our proctors (or other staffers) will check the details and deal with it. During the Japanese as a Foreign Language test Listening Comprehension and Listening-Reading Comprehension questions, in cases when noises or other occurrences interfere with your ability to adequately hear the audio contents, please raise your hand and immediately inform a staffer of the situation after completion of the Listening Comprehension and Listening-Reading Comprehension audio.

If not satisfied with the actions taken by our staffers at such times, you may directly appeal to the supervisors at each examination site. Please note, however, that the final judgments on such matters will be made by JASSO. Likewise, please be aware that issuing requests only after completion of the examination may prevent you from retaking the tests or benefiting from other relief measures.

(2) Notification of the Results to Examinees

You can check your score online and download the Score Confirmation Reports by creating “My Page” in EJU Online.

(3) Score Report to Universities (*)

Universities and others will be notified of examinees' scores as follows.

- a. When applying to a university, write your examination registration number, name in the Roman alphabet, date of birth, and other required information on the university's application form. If you are planning to take both the 1st session (June) and the 2nd session (November), write only the examination registration number of one session (whichever you prefer) on the university's application form. The scores submitted for respective subjects must be from the same session. **Submitting the scores from different sessions for respective subjects e.g. "the score of Japanese as a Foreign Language for the 1st session and the score of Japan and the World for the 2nd session" is not acceptable.**
- b. Some universities require students to have examination vouchers when applying, so **make sure you do not lose your voucher** until you have completed the enrollment.
- c. After the examination, the university to which you applied will request JASSO to provide your score.
- d. JASSO will provide the university, etc. with your score and, if you took the Japanese as a Foreign Language test, a copy of your answers for the writing section.

*We will also notify your score to the organization in response to grade inquiries related to the selection of MEXT Scholarships for Malaysian Students and Japan-Taiwan Exchange Association Scholarship students.

*Information on reservation holders to the Reservation Program for the Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students is likewise supplied to EJU Overseas Representatives (Application offices), with the purpose of helping to promote follow-up studies in Japan.

(4) Inquiries on Results

JASSO does not respond to inquiries or doubts raised by examinees concerning the results reported to them. Also, JASSO does not show or return the answer sheets to examinees after the examination.

13. Protection of Personal Information

JASSO will not disclose your personal information (your name, date of birth, country/region, address, photo, scores, answers, etc.) to any third party without your permission, except when reporting your scores to a university as you requested (see "12. Notification of the Results: (3) Score Report to Universities"), or when disclosure is necessary to the administration of the EJU or the international students support projects to be conducted by JASSO or the government. **However, upon inquiries from universities or other institutions regarding the scores of persons who have engaged in removal of examination questions from test sites in the past, proxy test-taking or other malicious prohibited behavior, they will be notified of the invalidation of the scores.**

14. Governing Law and Competent Court

With respect to the implementation, administration, results, and all other matters related to the 2026 EJU, Japanese law shall be the governing law, regardless of the applicant's nationality. Additionally, for any and all disputes related to EJU, the Tokyo District Court shall be the court of exclusive jurisdiction in the first instance.

(1) Question Booklet

- a. Do not open the question booklet until instructed to do so.
(If you do, it will be regarded as prohibited behavior.)
- b. **Make sure you do not take the question booklets out of the room after the examination.**
(If you do so, it will be regarded as prohibited behavior.)

(2) Answer Sheet

- a. For Japanese as a Foreign Language, two types of answer sheets (an answer sheet in a writing method and a mark-sheet) will be provided. For mathematics, science, Japan & the World, a mark-sheet will be provided.
- b. Your examination registration number and name (in Roman alphabet) will be pre-printed on your answer sheet from the beginning. When the answer sheet is handed out, first of all, check that the examination registration number and name on the answer sheet are the same as those on your examination voucher.
- c. For Japanese as a Foreign Language, please place a mark-sheet face down on your desk until the reading comprehension section begins. During writing tests, if you fail to keep your mark sheet face down it will be considered prohibited behavior.
- d. Write down all your answers on the answer sheet. Even if you write the answers on the question booklet, they will not be graded.
- e. The answer sheet in the writing method for Japanese will be collected when the writing section is over.
- f. Make sure you do not take out the answer sheets with you after the examination.
(Attempting to take or taking out will be regarded as prohibited behavior.)

(3) Notes about Marking the Mark-sheet

- a. In the mark-sheet method, select the answer you think is correct from the choices after the questions and fill in completely the corresponding number on the mark-sheet using an HB pencil.
- b. Make sure you use an HB pencil to fill in the oval of the number for the answer. **You cannot use a mechanical pencil or a ball-point pen.**
- c. Numbers that are filled in too lightly or not neatly will not be graded.
- d. When correcting incorrectly filled in numbers, erase completely using a plastic eraser so that no traces of the pencil remain. Numbers that are not completely erased will not be graded. You must not use things such as white-out in place of an eraser.

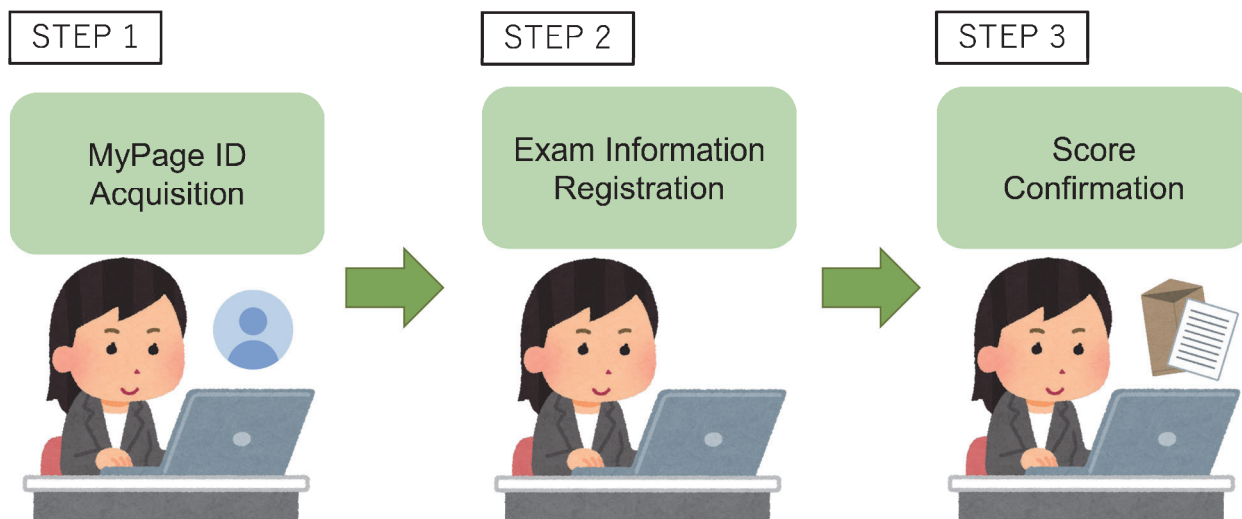

18. Reservation Program for Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students

JASSO offers Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students (Hereinafter called JASSO Scholarship) who attend a university or other institution of higher education in Japan. JASSO sponsors a reservation program for privately financed international students who achieve a superior score on EJU, and enroll as regular students in a university undergraduate school, a junior college, college of technology (3rd grade or upper), or a professional training college in Japan.

(1) Eligibility

Applicants taking the EJU 1st session in June 2026 or 2nd session in Nov. 2026 by any of the following eight subject test combinations, and enrolling as regular students (excluding research students, trainees, non-degree students, auditing students, etc.) in a university undergraduate school, a junior college, a college of technology (3rd grade or upper), or a professional training college in Japan between the period indicated in **(5) Enrollment Period and Duration of Scholarship**.

[Eight EJU subject test combinations]

- [1] Japanese as a Foreign Language only
- [2] Japanese as a Foreign Language and Mathematics (Course 1 or 2)
- [3] Japanese as a Foreign Language, Mathematics (Course 1 or 2) and Science
- [4] Japanese as a Foreign Language, Mathematics (Course 1 or 2) and Japan & the World
- [5] Japanese as a Foreign Language and Science
- [6] Japanese as a Foreign Language and Japan & the World
- [7] Mathematics (Course 1 or 2) and Science
- [8] Mathematics (Course 1 or 2) and Japan & the World

Those taking the English version of Mathematics (Course 1 or 2), Science, or Japan & the World tests are also eligible to apply.

Note 1: Those enrolling in a graduate school is not eligible.

Note 2: If a particular subject test combination is taken by a very small number of examinees, there may be cases when no reservation holders will be selected from that group.

(2) Scholarship Monthly Stipend

JPY 48,000 (The amount is subject to change each academic year.)

(3) Selection

Applicants whose EJU score is in the top rank among candidates will be reservation holders for this scholarship.

a. Applicants with superior score at overseas exam site

Those who achieved superior score for each subject test combination indicated in **(1) Eligibility** at overseas exam site will be selected as reservation holders with qualification for potential extension of scholarship duration.

b. Applicants with good score regardless of the exam site of EJU

Those who achieved good score for each subject test combination indicated in **(1) Eligibility** will be selected as reservation holders for single year scholarship.

(4) Application Procedure

In order to apply for this reservation program, examinees need to mark a circle in the designated box on the EJU application form.

(5) Enrollment Period and Duration of Scholarship

(6) Notification of the Selection Results

Applicants selected as reservation holders will be able to download Reservation Notice for Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students (hereinafter Reservation Notice) from “My Page” on EJU Online. Reservation Notice can be downloaded from the end of August for the 1st session and the end of January for the 2nd session. Please refer to **12. Notification of the Results** about EJU Online.

Their examination registration numbers can be confirmed on JASSO website regarding this Reservation Program.

(7) Scholarship Application

In order to receive scholarship, reservation holders need to notify JASSO about the school they will enroll in and submit the copy of their Reservation Notice to their school. They will be recommended by the school if you meet **(9) Scholarship Recipient Requirements** and approved as scholarship recipients by JASSO.

(8) Cancellation of Entitlement

Scholarship reservation will be cancelled if any of the following circumstances occurs.

- a. The reservation holders include false information or faults due to gross negligence in the application documents.
- b. The reservation holders fail to enroll in a university undergraduate school, a junior college, a college of technology (3rd grade or upper), or a professional training college in Japan during enrollment periods indicated in (5) Enrollment Period and Duration of Scholarship.
- c. The reservation holders become disqualified in any other aspect.

(9) Scholarship Recipient Requirements (as of December 2025)

To receive scholarship, a reservation holder must meet all of the following requirements.

- a. The student must have the status of residence of "Student" as defined in Appendix 1 to the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (Cabinet Order No. 319 of October 4, 1951), and may not be a Japanese Government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT) Scholarship Student or a foreign state-sponsored student as defined in the Guidelines for Implementation of the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship (Program) (established by the Minister of Education on March 31, 1954).
- b. The student must be enrolled as a regular student at a university undergraduate school, a junior college, a college of technology (3rd grade or upper), or a professional training college in Japan.
- c. The student should meet the JASSO Scholarship grading criteria (including language proficiency).
- d. The student must have intention to cooperate to the survey of academic and career status conducted by JASSO.
- e. The allowance sent from the student's private funding source may not exceed, on average, JPY90,000 per month (excluding admission and tuition fees).
- f. The annual income of a student's supporter residing in Japan may not exceed JPY5,000,000.
- g. The student who does not receive scholarship from another organization that does not allow its recipient to hold JASSO Scholarship.
- h. The student who does not receive Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Short-term Study in Japan), etc. by JASSO.
- i. The student should report to the international student affairs office at school once a month, in order to confirm the official record of attendance.

(10) Termination of Disbursements under the Reservation Program

Scholarship payments may be terminated after enrollment if any of the following situations occurs and the President of JASSO deems that termination is necessary.

- a. The student no longer fulfills all of requirements a. to h. in (9) Scholarship Recipient Requirements.
- b. The student's status of residence changes to a status other than "Student."
- c. The student transfers to another school or withdraws from school.
- d. The student's school reports that the student's academic standing, etc. is extremely poor.
- e. The student is determined to have provided false information in the submitted documents, etc.
- f. The student is suspended or expelled from school, or is subjected to other punishments by the school.
- g. The student fails to meet scholarship requirements/eligibility in any other situation.

(11) Other

Reservation holders who enroll as regular students at an institution that does not use EJU scores in its admission process remain eligible to request for their scholarship as long as they enroll in a university undergraduate school, a junior college, a college of technology (3rd grade or upper), or a professional training college in Japan.
