

## Basic Japanese for daily use

## Winter Course

- 1. Programs: Co-sponsored by Osaka International House Foundation, the course is designed for foreign nationals, whose levels of Japanese are beginner to upper intermediate, to gain Japanese conversation knowledge necessary for daily life. All the classes are given by the teachers of Osaka Japanese Language Education Center. WEB application
- 2. Eligibility: Foreigners who cannot converse well in Japanese

- First come First served
- \*As a rule, the course is for applicants who are older than 16 years old (high school student and/or above) and live or work in Osaka under own proper visa
- \*Applicants who are able to attend all the classes
- \*Applicants who have never studied in any level of the course before

If you have participated in any class of any level of the course before but still want to study in the course (the same level or different level class), note that your participation will be decided by the school lottery. Make sure to confirm application details on our home page.

3. Period of study: \*No lesson on Saturdays, Sundays, National holidays and Winter break (12/20 to 1/12)

Tuesday, December, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025 ~ Friday, March, 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026 Period of study

4. Hours & max intake: \*Beginner to Upper Intermediate: Up to 12 persons in each class (2 classes (50 minutes x2) a day)

Afternoon	Mon to Fri	1:10 pm. ~ 3:00 pm	Beginner /Intermediate /Upper Intermediate
Evening	Tue & Thu	4:10 pm. ~ 6:00 pm	Beginner (Beginner class only, 2 days a week only)

<sup>\*</sup> As for Beginner level, 2 classes in the morning and 2 classes in the afternoon are expected to be held.

- 5. Qualification: Applicants who have proper visa to stay in Japan throughout the course period
- 6. How to apply:
- Apply through the web address indicated on the section of Basic Japanese for daily use application details of Osaka Japanese Language Education Center (Face photo data needed for application)
  - · Application period: From Tuesday, October 28th, to Friday, November 7th, 2025
  - · Application web opening hours: 24 hours: from 9:00 AM on Oct. 28th to 12:00 PM on Nov. 7th.
- (When the application period is over, contact us through email for spot availability information) O No level check. Class level will be up to your choice
- As a rule, classes will be filled by first come, first served basis.
