

◆ 2026 Summer Course: Japanese Conversation Training  
Contents and Application Method ◆

The summer Japanese conversation course offers people who would like to improve their Japanese an intensive Japanese conversation class over a short period, helping them get more knowledges and understandings of Japanese language.

We welcome participations both from residents in Japan and abroad.

**1. Course**

**(1) Class**

- Duration From Tuesday, July 27<sup>th</sup> to Friday, August 14<sup>th</sup> 2026  
(For 14 days excluding Saturdays, Sundays and National holidays)
- Class Hours

	Hours	1 day study hours	Levels (one class for each level)
Class	10:10 -15:00	50 minutes x 4 periods	Beginner (2 classes), Intermediate (1 class)

- \* Up to 12 students per class (Level: Beginner and Intermediate)
- \* You will be studying the same level during the course period, and level changes are not permitted during the course. Select a level according to the applicant's level based on the "Level Guideline" below.
- \* Each level's application is based on a first-come, first-served basis, and application will close when it reaches maximum intake. In addition, depending on application status, we may adjust the number of students, or we may not be able to hold classes.

**(2) Class contents and Class process**

- The study materials (textbooks) for each level will be handed to you on the first day of course; July 27<sup>th</sup>. You will be studying Japanese conversation with the materials.
- Beginner and Intermediate: Study about 15 lessons from our original textbook + relevant part of the vocabularies + verb form prints.
- In class lesson up to 12 students per level
- Aiming for the "Objects" described in the "Level guidelines", we will focus on lessons according to the "contents" in the short period.
- Classes will be in Japanese only (no language other than Japanese in the classes)

## 2. How to apply

To apply for this course, Fill out application & agreement/acceptance forms on HP of Japan Student Services Organization → Osaka Japanese Language Education Center → "Summer Course". And email them to us. Make sure that you fill out all the necessary information and sign up for the paper.

Also, double check the application & agreement/acceptance before mailing.

(1) Each level will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Note that the application will close when each level reaches maximum intake.

(2) Attach a face photo taken within last 3 months in the required section.

(3) Apply by email. We do not accept applications by visit.

## 3. Application period

(1) Application period: From Tuesday, June 30<sup>th</sup> to Tuesday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2026

※ Contact us by phone if you do not receive reply mail within 3 business days.

## 4. Participation fee

(1) Participation fee: 65,000 yen/each class of level (including study materials)

\* Pay by bank transfer after invoice.

\* No refund after payment

\* Participation fee does not include such expenses as accommodation, transportations, meals and so forth.

(2) How to pay the participation fee

Once your application is accepted, we will inform you about the payment.

\* Notifications will be sent to the email address you sated in application form.

\* Participation fee need to be settled by bank transfer. Note that we do not accept cash.

## 5. Other

\* You need to arrange your own visa to enter Japan for the course

\* You need to prepare your accommodation to stay in Japan for the course.
