2. *Eligibility* : Foreigners who cannot converse well in Japanese

- \*As a rule, the course is for applicants who are older than 16 years old (high school student and/or above) and live or work in Osaka under own proper visa
- \*Applicants who are able to attend all the classes

\*Applicants who have never studied in any level of the course before

If you have participated in any class of any level of the course before but still want to study in the course (the same level or different level class), note that your participation will be decided by the school lottery. Make sure to confirm application details on our home page.

3. *Period of study:* %No class on Saturdays, Sundays and National holidays.

\*Due to school events, there will be no class one day each in Sep & Oct.,

4. *Hours & max intake* : \*Beginner to Upper Intermediate: around 12 persons in each class (2 classes (50 minutes x2) a day)

Afternoon	Mon to Fri	1:10 pm. $\sim$ 3:00 pm	Beginner/Intermediate/Upper Intermediate
Evening	Tue & Thu	4:10 pm. $\sim$ 6:00 pm	Beginner (Beginner class only, 2 days a week only)

\*As for Beginner level, 2 classes in the morning and 2 classes in the afternoon are expected to be held. \*Class switch becomes impossible when each class becomes full.

\*Due to the circumstances, the contents of course and number of intakes are subject to change.

5. Qualification : Applicants who have proper visa to stay in Japan throughout the course period.
