



# Basic Japanese for daily use

## Winter Course

1. **Programs**: Co-sponsored by Osaka International House Foundation, the course is designed for foreign nationals, whose levels of Japanese are beginner to upper intermediate, to gain Japanese conversation knowledge necessary for daily life. All the classes are given by the teachers of Osaka Japanese Language Education Center.

**\* Winter Course will be conducted by online (web lessons).**

Participants will be decided by the School lottery.

2. **Eligibility**: Foreigners who cannot converse well in Japanese
- \*As a rule, the course is for applicants who live or work in Osaka under own proper visa
  - \*Applicants who have never studied in any level of the course before
  - \*Applicants who are able to attend all the classes
  - \*If you have participated in any class of any level of the course before but still want to study in the course (the same level or different level class), note that your participation will be decided by the school lottery. Make sure to confirm the details with our home page.

3. **Period of study**: ※No lesson on Saturdays, Sundays and National holidays

4. **Hours & max intake**: **\* Beginner to Upper Intermediate: Up to 6 persons in each class**  
(2 classes (50 minutes x2) a day)

\*Class switch becomes impossible when each class is full.

5. **Qualification**: Applicants who have proper visa to stay in Japan throughout the course period
6. **How to apply**: Apply through the QR cord below between 9:00 AM of November 10<sup>th</sup> (Tuesday) and 11:00 PM of November 12<sup>th</sup> (Thursday). There will be no level check by the school. Your choice of level will be your class. : Note that when the number of applications exceeds the number of max intake, participants will be decided by school lottery. Also, if the number of applications doesn't reach max intake, the course can be canceled.



\*Applications received after or before the application period will be put on the waiting list

\*Note that application by telephone or by the school visit at the office cannot be accepted.

7. **Cost**: Morning or Afternoon ¥ 30,000 per person for each class including textbook. (※non-refund)  
Evening: ¥ 12,000 per person including textbook. (※non-refund)
- \* Non refund after payment
  - \* Settle the payment once after confirmation on your participation (Before the course starts)
  - \* Note that we don't accept cash, credit card and e-money.
